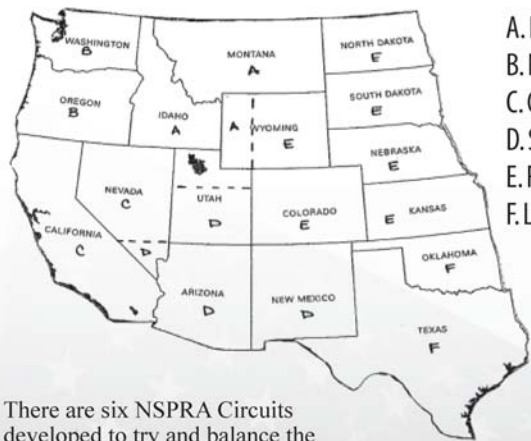


Circuit Information

There are six NSPRA Circuits developed to try and balance the rodeos and runs. Members can choose which circuit to compete in for circuit awards, but are also allowed to compete at any U.S. rodeo. Points earned at Circuit rodeos not only count for circuit awards, but also for World Standings. Circuit fee income collected at each rodeo will be distributed evenly between all circuits for year end awards. A circuit must have 4 rodeos in it to qualify for circuit awards.

The circuit concept will make it more attractive to members who can't travel all over the country. You'll still be able to compete and win points at your local rodeos and have a chance to win a beautiful wool jacket embroidered with the circuit championship logo
**The Northwest and Longhorn circuits currently do not qualify for circuit awards as they have not met the four rodeo requirement.
